



## **THE GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY GOLF PARTNERSHIP PRIVACY POLICY**

### **1. Background**

- 1.1 We are committed to safeguarding the privacy of everyone involved with The Gloucestershire Golf Partnership (GCGP); this policy sets out how we will treat your personal information.

### **2. What information do we collect about you?**

- 2.1 When you become involved with the GCGP we collect only the information required from you to be able to fulfil our contractual obligations, which includes being able to contact you with notices of Annual and General Meetings and events and competitions we hold.
- 2.2 With your permission, we may also collect further information which allows us to contact you regarding events and offers.
- 2.3 In the case of employees and volunteers of GCGP, we collect only the information required to fulfil the contractual relationship between us. We will only share this data with internal and external data processors.

### **3. How the information about you will be used**

- 3.1 When you enter an open competition event or take part in any organised activity, we may share your information with external and internal data processors (ClubV1, BRS, Howdidido etc.). Your personal information is controlled internally by the Club's Data Protection Officer (County Development Officer), who adheres to the internal and data protection policies and procedures of GCGP.

### **4. Marketing**

- 4.1 By being involved, you may have opted in for us to be able to correspond with you regarding our activities, including events and competitions, by means of post, telephone, email and SMS. We do not share your data with external marketing companies. If you have consented to this correspondence you have the right to opt out at any time.

## **5. Individual Rights**

- 5.1 You have the right to request a copy of the information we hold about you. If you would like a copy, please email the Data Controller (County Development Officer) at [gcdo@btinternet.com](mailto:gcdo@btinternet.com)
- 5.2 We wish to ensure that your personal information is accurate and up to date. You may ask us to correct or erase information that you believe to be inaccurate.
- 5.3 At the time of collecting data you have the right to object to the GCGP holding certain data about you.
